



Pilgrim Virgin Home Visitation Program

The Pilgrim Virgin Home Visitation Program is an aid to help us respond to the requests made by the Blessed Mother during her apparitions at Fatima. The essence of her requests is threefold: Return to God, that is, turn away from sin and obey the Ten Commandments. Pray the Rosary every day for peace. Make reparation for our sins and the sins of others by some form of penance and sacrifice. An offering of the sacrifices required in performing the daily duties of one's state in life is a good starting point.

Availability of the Pilgrim Virgin Statue (PVS) of Our Lady of Fatima for your home is managed by your local parish Legion of Mary Praesidium. You may contact your local parish Legion of Mary Praesidium, or you may reach out to the email address to schedule a home visit of the PSV. When you receive the PSV, you will also receive very detailed instructions provided in a Pilgrim Virgin Home Visitation Program book on how you may receive and join with the PSV daily in prayer while the PSV is in your home. The PSV may be received by you at your parish or brought to your home as you may request by a member of the Legion of Mary on a scheduled visit. The statue will typically stay in your home for one week (Saturday to Saturday).

You are asked to set up a special space (a shrine) where the PVS will be placed in your home. A table covering, candles (or vigil lights), flowers, and other desired sacramentals could be placed alongside the PVS in this place.

Upon the arrival of the PVS, any present can gather at the shrine where the statue is placed and recite the Welcoming Prayers in accordance with the instructions provided. You may invite friends and neighbors to welcome Mary upon her arrival and have them join you in prayer each day the statue is in your home. During this time, you are encouraged to recite the Rosary each day and offer prayer intentions, petitions, and gratitude to Mary in accordance with the instructions provided.

With a home delivery, two days prior to the statue's departure (the next Saturday), a Legion member will call to discuss the time that the statue will be picked up. Alternatively, you may make arrangements to drop off the PSV at your local parish to be received by your local Legion of Mary.

Upon the PSV's departure, you are encouraged to recite the Farewell Prayers provided in instructions.
